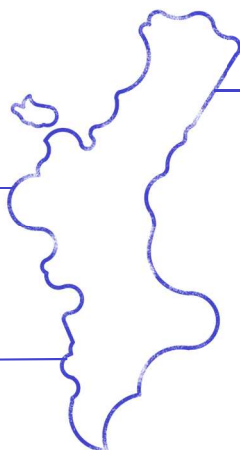
Birth rate

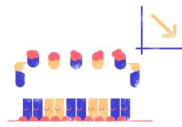

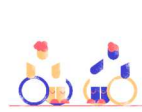
Population growth

Since 2012 there has been a **negative** trend, more negative even than the Spanish average.

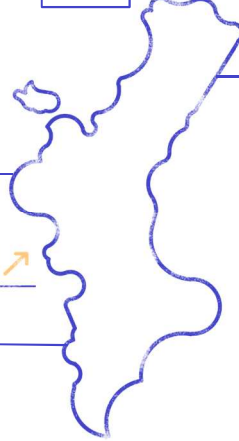


Dependency

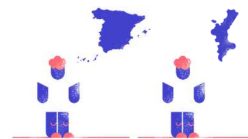


Aging

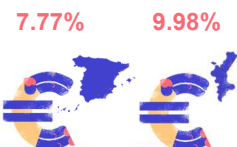

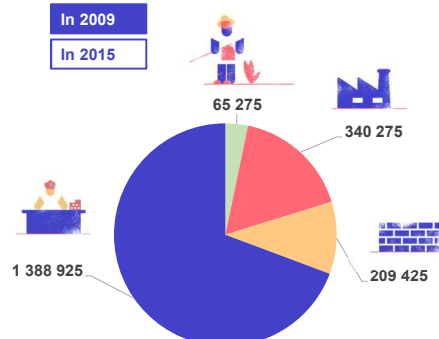

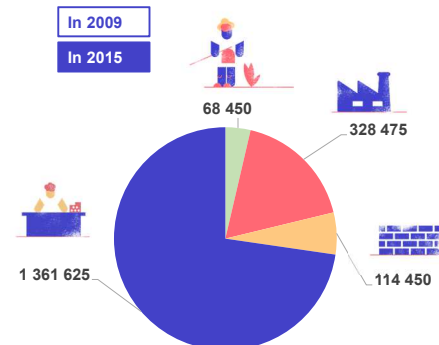

Valencian Country Sectoral structure

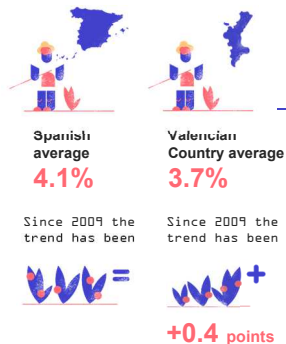

Main exports

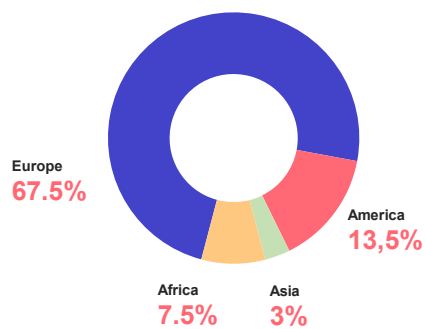

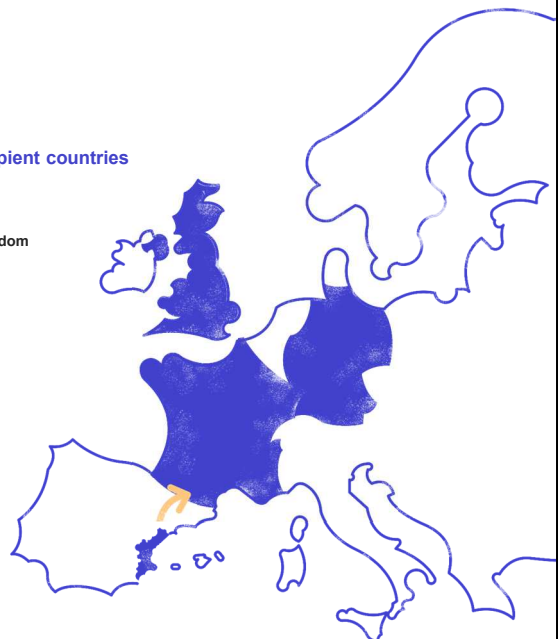

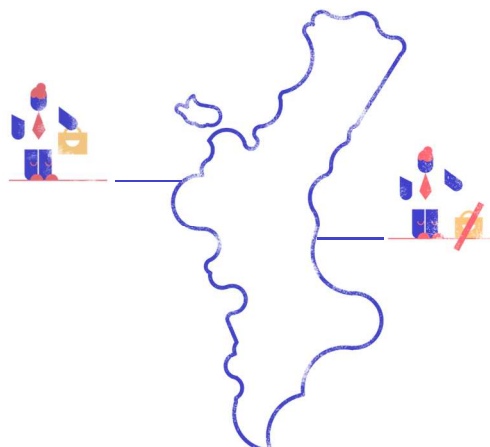

The **unemployment rate** has been clearly falling since 2012. The current rate is the lowest since 2009.

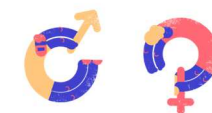

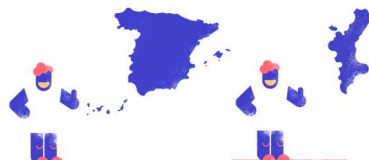

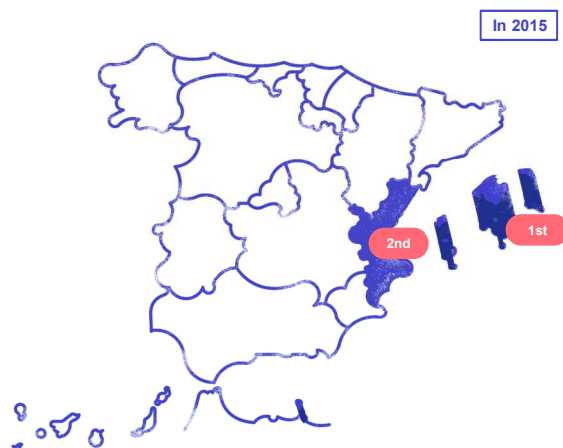

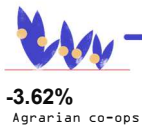

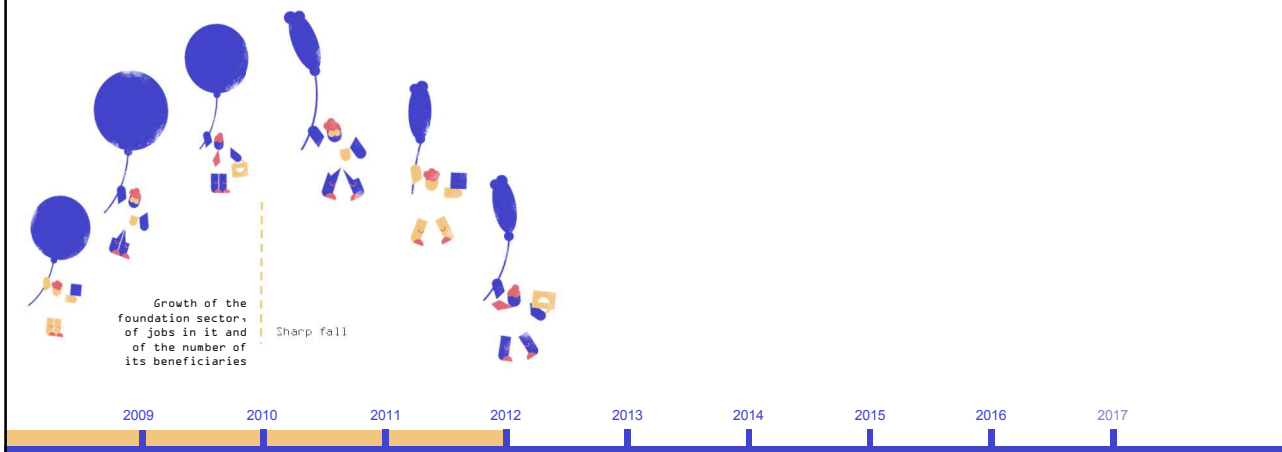
